To study only one language a and special concessions – reg

Government order Nos. 1&2 with reference to deaf and dumb children and children with learning disabilities and mentally retarded children studying in government recognized schools have to study all subjects in only one languages. They are exempted from studying the II and III languages. The director has recommended that in some schools these children studying in English medium. These children have to study I languages also. Therefore it is difficult to study two languages. They should not be compelled to study II & III languages. They may be permitted to study the languages (medium of instruction) as per the letter of 93. Based on this recommendation, the government had issued order no. SKK/141/PHP/12 dated 30-6-92.

As per this order, deaf and dumb children, students with special learning disability studying in government recognized schools can study only the languages of medium of instruction.

Apart from this, extra time is given to students with disabilities like

- 1. Slow writers
- 2. Students who have weak right hand and hence write slowly
- 3. Students who have weak right and hence use left hand are given extra time as follows
 - 1. For examinations with 21/2 3 hours 1 hour.
 - 2. For examinations 2 hours 45 minutes.
 - 3. For examinations 1 hours 30 minutes.

All these have been examined in detail and these concessions were given to the students studying in the 10th standard only.

It has been further examined and decided to extend these concessions to all students.

Hence the above mentioned concessions are applicable to studying in government recognized school from the 1^{st} to 10^{th} standard.
