ORDER :

1. In the G.O 1st read above, orders have been issued granting following two concessions to all the deaf and dumb students studying Engineering courses:-
 - 1) Exemption from payments of examination fee.
 - 2) Reduction of pass marks in each subject by 10%.
2. In the G.O 2nd read above, orders have been issued extending the above concessions to the hearing impaired and orthopedically handicapped students studying Engineering and pharmacy and also ordered that those of the orthopedically handicapped students studying Engineering and pharmacy who cannot use their hands freely for writing and have to necessarily use a scribe were 30 minutes extra time to write the University examination papers.
3. In the G.O 3rd read above, orders have issued extending the said concessions to the students of hearing impaired and orthopedically handicapped studying MBA/MCA professional courses.
4. In her representation 4th read above, Ms. T. Vijaya Deepthi D/o Venkata Rao, Visually challenged student studying in Engineering course has requested to consider for reduction of pass marks in each subject by 20% to enable to complete Engineering course.
5. The Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby order to extend the same concession as mentioned in para (1) above to the Visually Challenged students of Engineering, Pharmacy, MBA & MCA courses with immediate effect.
6. The commissioner of Director of Technical Education, Andhra pradesh, Hyderabad and Registrars of the Universities in the state are requested to take necessary further action in the matter.
