This Program is a great opportunity, for all of us as it is being conducted by Dr. J.P. Das himself who is a originator of these programs in the field of disability rehabilitation.


The program is based on the legendary theory of PASS (Planning, Attention, Successive and Simultaneous Processing) of intelligence modelled after Luria’s work.

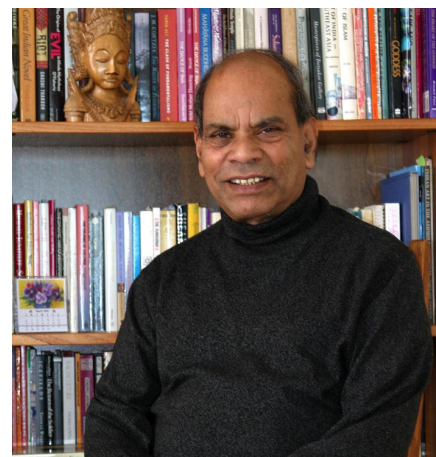
Current Research interests:

Module for Math

is a scientific research based program which improves all cognitive skills which are important for learning math skills. This is a program available to train a child in all pre-requisites of Math learning. As we know that cognition plays direct role in achievement of mathematic skill, the program is designed accordingly. It has 5 modules;

1. Shifting Patterns (Size and Value)
2. Let us Count (Numerosity)
3. Memory Span for Numbers (Working Memory)
4. Learning about Number Line
5. Mapping, Meaning and Estimating (Verbal and Non-Verbal Simultaneous processing)

Each module teaches the child in a very systematic way cognitive skills required for learning maths as well as language processing skills for Mathematics.

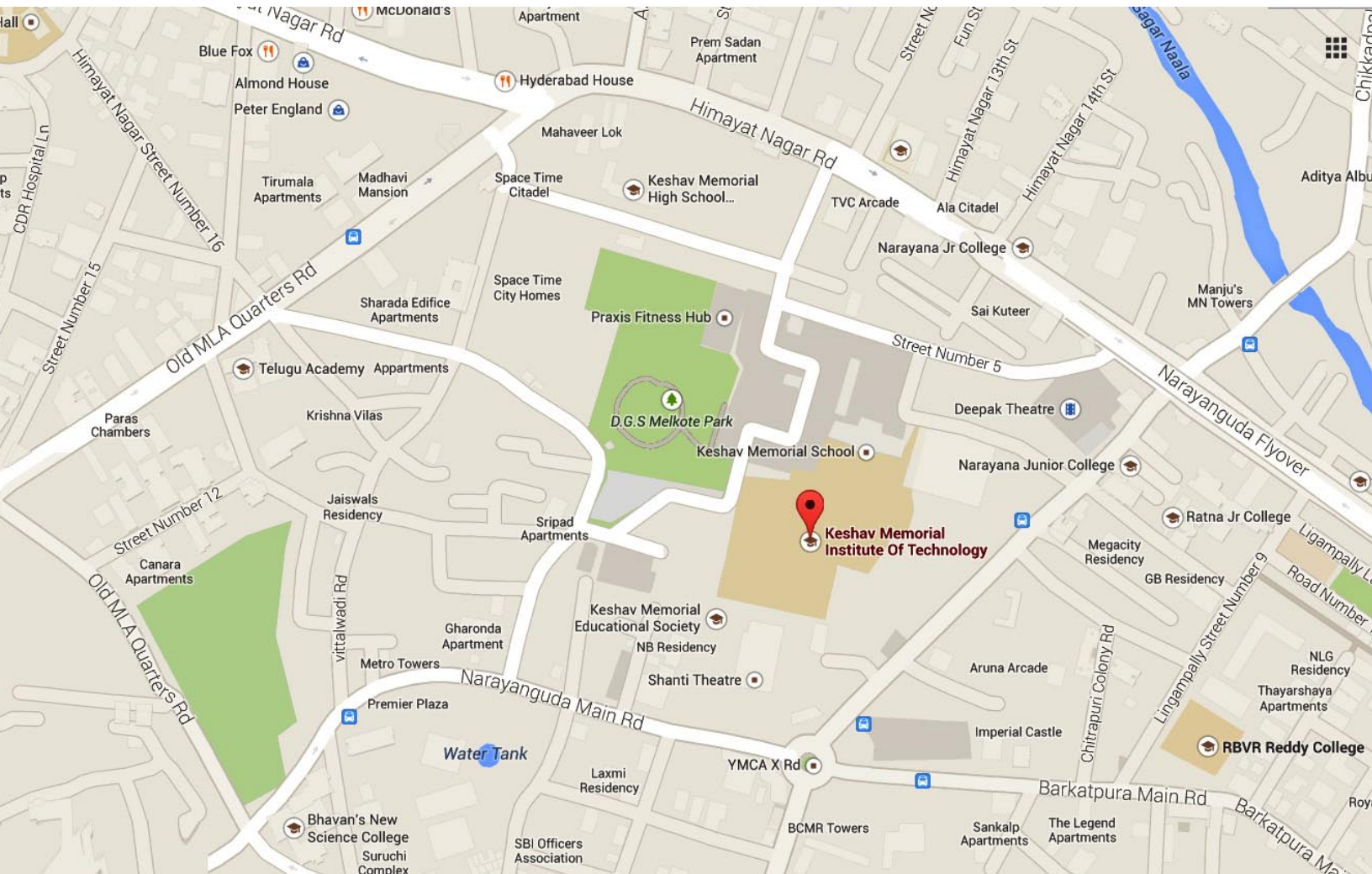

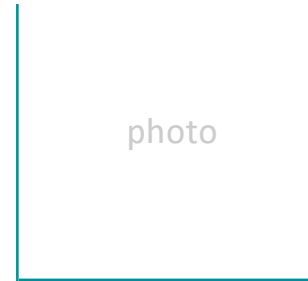
